You are in charge of how well you prepare (BE PROACTIVE). Use this chart to improve your playing (BEGIN WITH THE END IN MIND). Make time to practice (PUT FIRST THINGS FIRST). Your preparation helps the whole group (THINK WIN WIN). Listen carefully in rehearsal, then ask questions (SEEK FIRST TO UNDERSTAND, THEN TO BE UNDERSTOOD). Orchestra is a team effort (SYNERGIZE). Take care of yourself, your instrument, and your music (SHARPEN THE SAW). Have your best performance by following the first seven habits!(FIND YOUR VOICE)
